01	<p align="center">CONDITION OF TENDER PARA-06 :: REGISTRATION OF INDIAN AGENTS OF FOREIGN POLICY</p> <p>(i) As per the Compulsory Enlistment Scheme of the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Govt of India, it is compulsory for Indian agents who desire to quote directly on behalf of their foreign manufacturers/ principals, to get themselves enlisted with the Department of Expenditure, through the Central Purchase Organization (e.g. DGS&D).</p> <p>(ii) The Compulsory enlistment of Indian Agents under the scheme of Ministry of Finance is simpler and differs from the registration of Indian Agents with the Central Purchase Organization (e.g. DGS&D).</p> <p>(iii) The registration of the foreign manufacturer is not a must for enlisting the Indian Agent under this scheme. No Inspection Report in respect of the foreign manufacturer / principal is necessary.</p> <p>(iv) The enlistment under the scheme is not equivalent to the Registration with DGS&D. Such firms do not enjoy the same status as that of DGS&D registered suppliers. A note to this effect is given in the Enlistment letter to the firm.</p> <p>(v) However, offers from the Indian agents, who have applied to DGS&D for registration /enlistment before the time and date of opening of technical bid; such offers will be further processed if they can secure enlistment with DGS&D before opening of the Price Bids</p> <p>Note:- It is clarified that any bidder who is quoting a product of foreign OEM in whatsoever capacity, be it authorized dealer/ distributor or agent has to enlist itself with the DGS&D as an agent of the foreign principal.</p>	<p align="center">CONDITION OF TENDER PARA-06 ::REGISTRATION OF INDIAN AGENTS OF FOREIGN POLICY</p> <p align="right">- Deleted -</p>
