

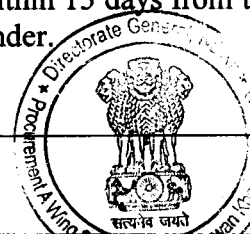

With reference to discussion/clarifications on points/suggestions relating to terms & conditions and specifications following changes/amendments/clarification be incorporated in the relevant terms & conditions and specifications given in the Tender Enquiry No.1-17018/NDRR/1502/HQ-NDRF/2018/4760 dated 06.07.2018 for procurement of 75000 Nos. Sleeping Bag for NDRR:-

The size of the logo on the center should be 45 cm wide and 30 cm high of the Sleeping Bag and visible logo at the size of 15 cm wide and 10 cm high should be printed on the pouch.
03.	Page 21 & 22 at para No.11 (Tender Sample) of General Terms and conditions of Contract: 11.0 Tender sample is required along with offer/bid. Tenderer are requested to deposit 01 No Sleeping Bag as tender sample in sealed box with DIG (Prov.) HQ DG NDRF, Pt. Deendayal Antyodaya Bhawan, 9th Floor, CGO Complex, New Delhi on due date and time of opening of tender. In case, tenderer fails to deposit tender sample on due date and time, offer/bid of the firm will be rejected. Physical evaluation of tender sample will be carried out by a detailed committee in presence of representative of firm in respect of those firms who qualify in technical evaluation. No extension for submission of tender sample shall be granted in any circumstances due to emergent requirement of the stores. The Tender sample will be kept with DIG (Prov.) HQ DG NDRF till finalization of tender.	03.	Page 21 & 22 at para No.11 (Tender Sample) of General Terms and conditions of Contract: 11.0 Tender sample is not required along with bid. 02 Nos. of sleeping bag as tender sample will be deposited by those firms which are qualified in technical evaluation on hearing from NDRF for which date and place will be intimated in due course. The sample will be tested from Wool Research Association by NDRF. Charges if any for testing shall be borne by the bidder. The sample and testing charges should be submitted within 10 days from the date of issue of letter from NDRF HQ, failing which offer of the firm is liable to be rejected. No extension for submission of tender sample and testing charges shall be granted in any circumstances due to emergent requirement of the stores. The bidders may note that letter for submission of the sample and test charges of the bag will be issued within 15 days from the date of opening of tender.

Approved Lab confirming specifications mentioned in this tender enquiry for their offered model/store issued in favour of OEM or his authorized dealers.
