1. All documents attached with these tender documents including the specifications are SACROSANCT for considering any offer as complete offer. It is therefore important that Tender acceptance letter which is a written undertaking that all the terms & condition of the tender are understood and accepted should be signed and submitted in original and online through e-procurement site <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>.

2. **CONDITIONS GOVERNING THE CONTRACT:-**

2.1 Apart from any special conditions contained in / attached to this tender documents, the condition contain in the below mentioned Pamphlets and Forms will form part of any contract made.

2.1.1 Pamphlet No. DGS&D-39 titled “Conditions of Contract, governing contracts placed by the Central Purchase Organization of the Government of India” as amended up to date.

2.1.2 Pamphlet No.DGS&D-229. [All condition of Rate Contract contained in Booklet of DGS&D – 229 will be applied in instant tender also].

2.1.3 DGS&D Form No.68 (Revised).

2.2 **Amendments:** The following amendments may be carried out in the Pamphlet entitled “Conditions of Contract Governing the contracts placed by Central Purchase Organization of Government of India” 1991 edition bearing Symbol DGS&D-39 form No.DGS&D-68 (Revised).

2.2.1 The definition of “Government” provided in clause 1 (f) page 2 of DGS&D Conditions of Contract may be amended as under:-

“Government” means the Central Government

2.2.2 The definition of **Secretary** Clause 1 (k)-page 3 of DGS&D Conditions of Contract may be modified as under:-

“Secretary” means Secretary of Min. of Home Affairs for the time being in the administrative charge of the subject matter of contract and included Additional Secretary, Special Secretary, Joint Secretary, or Director or Dy. Secy. in such Ministry, Director General, Inspector General (NDRF),DIG (NDRF), of this Dte. and every other officer authorized for the time being to execute contracts relating to purchase and supply of stores on behalf of the President of India

2.2.3 Under Clause 2 (c)-page 5 of DGS&D Conditions of contract, the word “Director General of Supplies & Disposals or heads of his concerned regional offices” may be replaced by **Director General (National Disaster Response Force), Ministry of Home Affairs.**

2.2.4 Following amendments may be carried out in the Pamphlet No DGS&D-229 containing various instructions to tenders:-

Form NoDGS&D-230.

Reference to DGS&D wherever appearing in clause No14,33,34,35,39 and 40 and Appendix ‘A’ for Form No. DGS&D-96 may be amended to read as **Deputy Inspector General, NDRF HQrs, Ministry of Home Affairs.**

2.2.5 Clause 24 i.e. Arbitration:- In the existing entries/clause 24 of DGS&D - 68 (Revised) substitute DG, NDRF for DG, DGS&D.

3. If you are in a position to quote for supply in accordance with the requirements stated in the attached schedule to tender, all documents attached herewith should be duly filled in, signed and **submitted online through e-procurement site <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>**
4. **PURCHASER'S DISCRETION:-** Director General NDRF reserves the right to:-
 - 4.1 Cancel /reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason.
 - 4.2 Increase or decrease the quantity at any stage without assigning any reason.
 - 4.3 Change the consignees and allocation of quantities at any stage without assigning any reason
5. **PURCHASE PRICE PREFERENCE :-** Give a purchase / price preference to offers from public sector units and SSI units over other firms in accordance with the policies of the Govt from time to time.
6. **EARNEST MONEY**
 - 6.1 Firms not registered with NSIC or DGS&D for the subject stores for which the offers are being invited, are required to deposit EARNEST MONEY (EM) equivalent to the amount as mentioned in the tender schedule.
 - 6.2 Firms registered for any other stores and not for the stores indicated in the Tender schedule will be treated as unregistered, and shall be required to deposit specified Earnest Money.
 - 6.3 Tender received from Firm which is not registered with DGS&D or NSIC for the tendered stores, and is not accompanied with required Earnest money in the prescribed form, is liable to be rejected. Registration with any other authority will not exempt the firm from depositing Earnest Money.
 - 6.4 Public sector undertaking or central/state owned companies are not exempted from the payment of Earnest Money unless registered with DGS&D/NSIC for subject stores.
 - 6.5 **Earnest Money can be deposited in any one of the following forms, before bid submission end date physically otherwise bids will be liable for rejection:-**
 - 6.5.1A crossed Bank draft drawn in favour of **PAO, NDMA, New Delhi**. The draft should be payable at SBI (Safdarjung Enclave), New Delhi or any nationalized bank located in Delhi / New Delhi.
 - 6.5.2A **An irrevocable Bank Guarantee (BG) in the name of PAO, NDMA, New Delhi - 110066** of any Nationalized/Scheduled bank. The Bank guarantee should be payable at SBI (Safdarjung Enclave), New Delhi or any nationalized bank located in Delhi / New Delhi. The format is as per **Appendix-6**. **If EMD is furnished in the form of BG, then it should be valid for 45 days beyond the validity period of the offer.**
 - 6.5.3A FDR drawn in favour of **PAO, NDMA, New Delhi**. The FDR should be payable at SBI (Safdarjung Enclave), New Delhi.
 - 6.5.4 Foreign bidders should submit Earnest Money only in form of Bank Guarantee confirmed by any Nationalized /Scheduled Bank of India.
 - 6.6 The Earnest money shall be valid and remain deposited with the purchaser for the prescribed period in schedule-II. If the validity of the tender is extended, the validity of EM document submitted by the Tenderer shall also be suitably extended by the Tenderer,



failing which his tender, after the expiry of the aforesaid period shall not be considered by the purchaser.

- 6.7 No interest shall be payable by the purchaser on the EM deposited by Tenderer.
- 6.8 The EM deposited is liable to be forfeited if the Tenderer withdraws/ amends/ impairs/ derogates from the tender in any respect within the period of validity of his tender.
- 6.9 The EM of the successful Tenderer shall be returned after the Performance Security Deposit as required in terms of the resulting contract is furnished by the firm.
- 6.10 If the successful Tenderer fails to furnish the Performance Security Deposit as required in the contract within the stipulated period, the Earnest Money (EM) shall be liable to be forfeited by the purchaser.
- 6.11 EM of the unsuccessful Tenderers shall be returned within 30 days of finalization of tender. Tenderers are advised to send a pre-deposited challan along with their bids to facilitate refund of Earnest Money in time.
- 6.12 Similarly, firms who are registered for the subject stores with NSIC/DGS&D but with a certain monetary limit will be treated as unregistered for the tender value exceeding their monetary limit of registration. Such firms shall be required to deposit earnest money proportionate to the value of EM exceeding monetary limit. In case, any such firm fails to deposit earnest money, its offer for the tender value in whole or the part exceeding its monetary limit is liable to be ignored.

7. CAPACITY VERIFICATION:- Tenderers must submit the details of their plant and machinery on standard Performa enclosed with this TE irrespective of their registration status. Purchaser reserves the right to get the manufacturing capacity of any Tenderer re-verified through its representative or any inspecting agencies, irrespective of their registration status.

8. COMPULSORY ENLISTMENT OF INDIAN AGENT:-

- 8.1 As per the Compulsory Enlistment Scheme of the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Govt of India, it is compulsory for Indian agents who desire to quote directly on behalf of their foreign manufacturers/ principals, to get themselves enlisted with the Department of Expenditure, through the Central Purchase Organization (e.g. DGS&D).
- 8.2 The Compulsory enlistment of Indian Agents under the scheme of Ministry of Finance is simpler and differs from the registration of Indian Agents with the Central Purchase Organization (e.g. DGS&D).
- 8.3 The registration of the foreign manufacturer is not a must for enlisting the Indian Agent under this scheme. No Inspection Report in respect of the foreign manufacturer / principal is necessary.
- 8.4 The enlistment under the scheme is not equivalent to the Registration with DGS&D. Such firms do not enjoy the same status as that of DGS&D registered suppliers. A note to this effect is given in the Enlistment letter to the firm.
- 8.5 However, offers from the Indian agents, who have applied to DGS&D for registration /enlistment before the time and date of opening of technical bid; such offers will be further processed if they can secure enlistment with DGS&D before opening of the Price Bids

Note:- It is clarified that any bidder who is quoting a product of foreign OEM in whatsoever capacity, be it authorized dealer/ distributor or agent has to enlist itself with the DGS&D as an agent of the foreign principal

9. FOR FOREIGN BIDDERS/OEMs ONLY:-

It shall also be confirmed by foreign bidder(s)/OEM that, there are no Govt restrictions or limitation in the country of the supplier or countries from which sub-components are being procured and / or for the export of any part of the system being



supplied. Suppliers/Contractors shall obtain a certificate to this effect or authority concerned of their country and attached with technical bid

10. TENDER COST:-

- 10.1 Tenderers must enclose Demand Draft of tender cost in favour of **PAO, NDMA, New Delhi** payable at SBI New Delhi or any Nationalized Bank located in Delhi or New Delhi as per scheduled-II
- 10.2 Only SSI, Firms registered with NSIC or DGS&D are exempted from Tender Cost, However their registration must be valid on the Tender opening date
- 10.3 The tender received without the required Bank Draft (Tender Cost) will be liable for rejection.

11. **TWO BID SYSTEM:** Tenderers are required to submit their offers ONLINE in two bid system i.e. in separate sealed as under:-

11.1 FIRST FOLDER SHOULD CONTAIN THE SCANNED COPIES OF FOLLOWING ELIGIBILITY INFORMATION (IN .PDF FILES):-

11.1.1 Scanned copy of Technical bid along with its specification leaflets, brochure, if any. Composition of technical bid like:-

- a) Scanned copy of all the 5 schedules duly signed on each phase by the tenderer
- b) Scanned copy of appendices (1 to 7 & 9 to10) duly filled in along with Lab test report (if applicable).
- c) Scanned copy of any other relevant document which the firm wishes to submit,
- d) Scanned copy of Technical details/leaflets/brochure of subject stores as per specifications.
- e) Scanned copy of ECS Mandate Format

11.1.2 Scanned copy of documents of Earnest money

11.1.2 Scanned copy of documents of Earnest money

OR

Scanned copy of DGS&D/ NSIC registration certificate

11.1.3 Scanned copy of PAN Number/ Proprietor's Individual PAN No. in case of Proprietorship concerns.

11.2 SECOND FOLDER SHOULD CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING:-


11.2.1 Price bid / Financial Bid to be submitted ONLINE as per financial Bid proforma (Appendix-8 of this tender documents) i.e to be filled in the BOQ (excel worksheet).

11.2.2 Tenderer will attach copies of Govt. Notification in support of all applicable Taxes/Duties quoted in the offer (in PDF format).

11.3 Only the Technical Bid will be opened on the date indicated for Tender opening. Price bids of only those firms will be considered for opening whose offers are complete in all respect and fulfill the requirements as per specification/QRS and qualifies all technical requirements and terms & conditions as per TE. However, purchaser reserve the right to cancel/reject the tender/offer without assigning any reminder.

12. PRICE

12.1 The Tenderers are required to quote prices on free delivery to consignee basis. Price will be quoted in figures as well as in words Indian currency only. L-1 for the store item will be decided inclusive of all Taxes / Duties and all other leviable charges. Format for submission of Price Bid is attached with Tender Enquiry at Appendix-8.




- 12.2 Firms should quote for the entire quantity/package, however, price break up wherever asked in the price bid is required to be given. Offers without the price break up are liable to be rejected.
- 12.3 Price quoted should be firm and final and no increase of what so ever due to increase in statutory levies or other taxes would be admissible to the firm.
- 12.4 Benefit of decrease in levies will be passed on to the purchaser.
- 12.5 Tenderers are required to indicate Basic Prices, Custom Duty, Excise Duty, Sales Tax/VAT and any other leviable taxes/ charges separately within the Performa for Price Bid given at Annexure-8. Taxes/ duties/ charges reflected outside the Performa will not be accepted. Tenderer must attach copies of Govt. Notification in support of all applicable Taxes/ duties/charges quoted in the offer.

13. **EXEMPTION FROM DUTIES/TAXES:-** Customs and / or any other exemption certificate will not be given unless applicable on production of Govt. notifications in this regard through a formal request from the Tenderers.

14. TENDER SAMPLE

- 14.1 Requirement of Tender sample: Tender sample is not required along with offer/bid at the time of opening of tender. However, tenderers are required to submit detailed drawing/sketches and other technical details of proposed fabrication works to be carried out and materials to be used etc. These will be examined by a technical evaluation committee detailed by DG NDRF as part of technical evaluation. Based on their recommendation the qualifying firms will be subjected to physical evaluation by physical evaluation committee to be detailed DG NDRF. These qualifying firms will be required to produce a scaled model of proposed fabrication using the actual quality of raw materials to be used in the final fabrication. These models shall be prepared and produced for physical evaluation within two weeks from the date of opening of tender. The physical evaluation committee may also evaluate any ongoing/completed/existing fabrication at the works of the bidders before making their recommendation for manufacturing capability and required quality of works of the bidders during physical evaluation.
- 14.2 Technical and physical evaluation of technical bids and samples will be carried out by the detailed committee of DG NDRF in presence of the representative of participated firms, and the offer of only those firms will be process further who compiles in technical evaluation of technical bids. It means only technically qualified firms will produce the **above scaled models** for physical evaluation. The said **scaled models** should be produce by the participating bidders before detailed committee for physical evaluation at the place and time intimated by HQ DG NDRF, failing which offer of the firms is liable to be rejected. No extension for submission of **scaled models** will be granted in any circumstances due to emergent requirement of the stores.
- 14.3 Tenderer shall furnish test report certificate from ILAC/NABL/ Govt Approved Lab conforming to specifications procedure mentioned in Schedule-V.
- 14.4 The Lab test report (Original) submitted by the tenderer should be free from any ambiguity and should give clear verdict in respect of all the tests required as per relevant specification i.e. whether the sample is meeting the requirement of the governing specifications and the sample is acceptable / not acceptable with reference to its governing specification. The Lab Test Report should not be older 06 months from the date of issue of Tender Notice. The Lab Test Report obtained before 06 months from the date issue of Tender Notice will not be considered.
- 14.5 The purchaser also reserves the right to carry out the inspection/lab test of the samples submitted by the tenderer at any stage and the cost of test from the ILAC/NABL/ Govt Approved Lab or any other agency should be borne by the tenderers.



14.6 **All scaled models** should have cards affixed on them duly signed and stamped by the firm indicating the following:-

- Name and address of the firm
- Tender No. with date of opening
- Name of item, item No & size

14.7 **All scaled models** should have card affixed duly signed and stamped by concerned lab issued the Lab Test Report of the intended tender sample otherwise the offer is liable for rejection.

14.8 **Scaled models** sent on “**FREIGHT TO PAY**” basis will not be accepted and the tenderer would submit sample on No cost and No commitment basis.

14.9 **The Scaled models may be utilized by the purchaser for carrying out Physical Evaluation on all the parameters of Specifications including destructive Test. In that case the cost of sample will be borne by the supplier.**

14.10 **Scaled models** submitted by the tenderers whose offers are not accepted may be collected by their authorized representatives on requisition or hearing from NDRF. In case samples are not collected within given time, the samples will be disposed off.

15. **DISPATCH INSTRUCTIONS AND DOCUMENTATION**:- The Tenderer shall intimate to the purchaser, by telex or fax and speed post 07 working days in advance, the mode of transport and probable date of delivery of consignment.

16. **PACKING & MARKING**: as per clause 12 of the general condition of contract DGS&D-68 (revised).

17. **SUPPLY OF ORDERED STORES**

17.1 Successful bidder will be required to fabricate one prototype vehicle before bulk production. The prototype will be inspected/physically evaluated by a committee detailed by DG NDRF. The bidder will be required to carry out all the suggestive changes / modifications not found matching the tender specifications/conditions at their risk and cost. The firm will be given only once chance to complete all the suggested changes/ modifications, failing which their contract is liable to be cancelled. Bulk production clearance will be issued only after the prototype is accepted in all respects.

17.2 Bulk supplies in the case of successful Tenderers should conform to **Scaled models** accepted in trial evaluation in all respect besides specifications mentioned in Schedule-V.

17.3 Tenderers will be fully responsible for proper testing and making the equipment functional before acceptance of stores and the final settlement of account.

17.4 The stores supplied should be of best quality and free from all defects. Each consignment will be insured by the firm at their cost against transit risk till reach its destination as the insurer will not accept claims after specified period, the consignment shall be clear within 03 days and transit damage, loss if any shall be reported to the firm within 30 days of arrival of consignment at the destination.

18. **RIGHT TO REJECTION**

18.1 The decision of the DG NDRF shall be final as to the quality of the store and shall be binding upon the Tenderers and in case of any of the articles supplied not being found as per specification shall be liable to be rejected or replaced and any expenses or losses caused to the suppliers should be borne by the supplier and ensured by the supplier that articles supplied should be best in quality and free from all defects.

18.2 The acceptance of articles will be made only when the articles are inspected and found up to the standard specifications and free from all defects.

18.3 The rejected stores must be removed by the Tenderers from the consignee's premises within 15 days from the date of the intimation about rejection at the risk and cost of the Tenderer.



18.4 The In-charge stores concerned will take reasonable view of such materials but in no case shall be responsible for any loss, shortage, damage that may occur to it while it is in the premises of the consignee.

19. PENALTY FOR DELAY IN SUPPLY AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:

- 19.1** In case the firm does not complete the supply within the delivery period, action will be taken against the firm as per Para 15.7 of DGS&D Manual and Para 14.7(i) of Ministry of Commerce, Deptt. of Supply of the General condition of the contract.
- 19.2** Penalty @ 0.5 % per week or part thereof of the contract value shall be levied for delay in supply subject to a maximum of 10%.

20. DELIVERY OF STORES

- 20.1** Free delivery to consignee(s) basis.
- 20.2** Delivery period will include the inspection and replacement of rejected lot.
- 20.3** Firm should not deliver stores to consignee(s) beyond scheduled Delivery Period without obtaining prior sanction of purchaser.
- 20.4** In case, Firm deliver stores after scheduled Delivery Period, even if the stores are accepted by the consignee, it would be at the risk and cost of the seller as the supply may not be taken as contractually accepted.
- 20.5** No grace period will be provided after the stipulated delivery period.
- 20.6** No lead time will be given.

21. OPTION CLAUSE:- The Purchaser reserves the right to place order on the successful Tenderer for additional quantity up to 25% of the quantity offered by them at the time of placement of order or during the currency of the contract as per Clause 31 of Form DGS&D-68 (Revised).

22. FALL CLAUSE: Fall Clause will be applicable as under:-

- 22.1** The price charged for the stores supplied under the contract by contractor shall in no event exceed the lowest price at which the contractor sells the store item or offer to sell store of identical description to any persons/ organization during the currency of this contract.
- 22.2** If the contractor, at any time, during the currency of contract reduces the sale price, sells or offer to sell such store to any person/ organization at a price lower than the price chargeable under the contract, it shall forthwith notify such reduction or sale or offer of sale to the Director General, NDRF and the price under the contract would be reduced accordingly.

23. RISK PURCHASE CLAUSE:

- 23.1** In the event of failure of the supplier to deliver or dispatch the stores or provide the required services within the stipulated date/ period of the supply order A/T, or in the event of breach of any of the terms and conditions of the AT, the purchaser will have the right to purchase the store elsewhere at the risk and cost of the defaulting supplier after giving a notice to the defaulting supplier. The cost as per Risk Purchase exercise may be recovered from the bills pending with the supplier even against any other supplies outside this contract or even from the pending bills with any other Government Department/Ministry.
- 23.2** In the event of a contract being cancelled for any breach committed and the purchaser effecting re-purchase of the store at the risk and the cost of the contractor, the purchaser is not bound to accept the lower offer of Benami or allied or sister concern of the contractor.

24. PERFORMANCE SECURITY



- 24.1 The Performance Security would be required within 15 days from the date of issue of AT / confirmed supply order and would be released after the obligations of the firm are successfully met.
- 24.2 In terms of Clause-7 of condition of contract DGS&D-68 (revised) all the successful Tenderers irrespective of their registration status with DGS&D and NSIC shall be required to furnish an amount equal to 10% of the contract value as security deposit as guarantee against its own performance under the contract within 15 days of issue of contract. It should be valid up to 60 days beyond the expiry of Warrantee / Guarantee period.
- 24.3 In case Performance Security is not deposited by the successful bidder within the stipulated time from the placing of AT / Supply order, irrespective of any reason, EMD could be permanently forfeited and AT / Supply order would become liable for cancellation at the risk of the Firm.

25. PAST PERFORMANCE STATEMENT

- 25.1 Bidder should have supplied at least 25% of the quantity of the items stipulated in this Tender documents or similar type of stores in the last 3 years.
- 25.2 Tender should submit their performance statement in the enclosed proforma attached at Appendix-4 of Tender documents.
- 25.3 The decision on the assessment of the past performance of the Tenderer by DG NDRF will be final.

26. LAW GOVERNING THE CONTRACT

- 26.1 The contract shall be governed by the laws in force as of date in India and interpretation would be done accordingly.
- 26.2 Jurisdiction of Court: The courts of the New Delhi shall alone have jurisdiction to decide any dispute arising out of or in respect of the contract.

27. ARBITRATION

- 27.1 Arbitration proceedings shall be held at New Delhi, India and the language of the arbitration proceedings and that of all documents and communications between the parties shall be English.
- 27.2 In the case of dispute or difference arising between the purchaser and the supplier relating to any matter arising out of or connected with the contract, such dispute or difference shall be settled in accordance with the Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.
- 27.3 Sole arbitration will be by Secretary, Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India or by some other person appointed by him. As provided in clause 24 of General Condition of Contract Form DGS&D -68 Ministry of Commerce Department of supply.

28. PENALTY FOR USE OF UNDUE INFLUENCE

- 28.1 The Seller should undertake that he has not given, offered or promised to give directly or indirectly any gift, consideration, reward, commission, fees brokerage of inducement to any person in service of the Purchaser or otherwise in procuring, the Contracts or Forbearing to do or for having done or forborne to do any act in relation to obtaining or execution of the Contract or any other Contract with the Government for showing or forbearing to show favour or disfavour to any person in relation to the Contract or any other Contract with the Government.
- 28.2 Any breach of the aforesaid undertaking by the seller or any one employed by him or acting on his behalf (whether with or without the knowledge of the seller) or the commission of any offers by the seller or any one employed by him or acting on his behalf, as defined in Chapter IX of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 or the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1947 or any other Act enacted for the prevention of corruption shall entitle the Purchaser to cancel the contract and all or any other contracts with the seller and recover from the seller the amount of any loss arising from such cancellation.



- 28.3 A decision of the Purchaser or his nominee to the effect that a breach of the undertaking had been committed shall be final and binding on the seller.
- 28.4 Giving or offering of any gift, bribe or inducement or any attempt at any such act on behalf of the seller towards any officer/employee of the Purchaser or to any other person in a position to influence any officer/employee of the Purchaser for showing any favour in relation to this or any other contract, shall render the Seller liable for penalty as the Purchaser may deem proper including but not limited to termination of the contract, imposition of penalty damages, forfeiture of the Bank Guarantee and refund of the amounts paid by the Purchaser.

29. AGENT AND AGENCY COMMISSION

- 29.1 The seller confirms and declares to the purchaser that the seller is the original manufacturer of the stores referred to in this contract and has not engaged any individual or firm, whether Indian or Foreign whatsoever, to intercede, facilitate or in any way to recommend to the Government of India or any of its functionaries, whether officially or unofficially, to award the contract to the seller, nor has any amount been paid, promised or intended to be paid to any such individual or firm irrespective of any such intercession, facilitation or recommendation.
- 29.2 The Seller agrees that if it is established at any time to the satisfaction of the purchaser that the present declaration is in any way incorrect or if at a later stage it is discovered by the purchaser that the seller has engaged any such individual / firm, and paid or intended to pay any amount gift, reward, fees, commission or consideration to such personal party, firm or institution, whether before or after the signing of this contract the seller will be liable to refund that amount to the purchaser.
- 29.3 The purchaser will also have a right to consider cancellation of the contract either wholly or in part, without any entitlement or compensation to the seller who shall in such eventuality be liable to refund all payment made by the Buyer in terms of the contract along with interest at the rate of 2% per annum above LIBOR rate. The purchaser will also have the right to recover any such amount from any contracts concluded earlier with the Government of India.
- 29.4 The seller will also be debarred from entering into any supply contract with the Government of India for a period as deemed fit by the purchaser.

30. ACCESS TO THE BOOKS OF ACCOUNT

In case it is found to the satisfaction of the Purchaser that the Seller has engaged an Agent or paid commission or influenced any person to obtain the contract as described in clauses relating to Agents/Agency Commission and penalty for use of undue influence, the Seller, on a specific request of the Purchaser shall provide necessary information/inspection of the relevant financial documents/information.

31. PATENT AND OTHER INDUSTRIAL/INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHT

- 31.1 The prices quoted in the present tender shall be deemed to include all amounts payable for the use of patents, copyright, registration charges, trademarks and payment for any other industrial property rights.
- 31.2 The Tenderer shall indemnify the Purchaser against all claims from a third party at any time on account of the infringement of any or all the rights mentioned in the previous paragraphs, whether such claims arise in respect of manufacture or the use. The tenderer shall be responsible for the completion of the supplies, irrespective of the fact of infringement of any or all the rights mentioned above.

32. TRANSFER AND SUB-LETTING:- The Tenderer has no right to give, bargain, sell, assign or sublet or otherwise dispose of the resultant contract or any part thereof, as well as to give or to let a third party take benefit or advantage of the resultant contract or any part thereof.



33. FORCE MAJEURE CLAUSE: If at any time, during the continuance of this contract, the performance in whole or in part by either party of any obligation under this contract shall be prevented or delayed or becomes impossible or unlawful by reason of any war, hostility, acts of public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, explosions, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lockouts or act of God (hereinafter referred to "events") provided, notice of the happening of any such event is given by either party to the other within 21 days from the date of occurrence thereof, neither party shall by reason of such event, be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any claim for damages against the other in respect of such non-performance or delay in performance, and deliveries under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after such event has come to an end or ceased to exist, and the decision of the Purchaser as to whether the deliveries have been so resumed or not, shall be final and conclusive, PROVIDED FURTHER that if the performance in whole or part or any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by reason of any such event for a period exceeding 60 days, either party may at its option terminate the contract provided also that if the contract is terminated under this clause, the purchaser shall be at liberty to take over from the contractor at a price to be fixed by the Purchaser, which shall be final, all unused, undamaged and acceptable materials, bought out components and stores in course of manufacture in the possession of the contractor at the time of such termination or such portion thereof as the purchaser may deem fit excepting such materials, bought out components and stores as the contractor may with the concurrence of the purchaser elect to retain.

34. TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

- 34.1 Time shall be the essence of the contract
- 34.2 The Purchaser shall have the right to terminate this Contract without any notice in part or in full in any of the following cases:-
 - 34.2.1 The delivery of the material is delayed for causes not attributable to Force Majeure after the scheduled date of delivery.
 - 34.2.2 The Seller is declared bankrupt or becomes insolvent.
 - 34.2.3 The delivery material is delayed due to causes of Force Majeure by more than 60 days.
 - 34.2.4 In case Performance Security is not furnished within 15 days from the date of issuing of AT.
 - 34.2.5 In case the seller fails to supply the store within scheduled delivery period in which case Performance Security Deposit shall also be forfeited.

35. CORRESPONDENCE PROCEDURE

- 35.2 Tenderers are requested to write full name and designation of authorized signatory on all the correspondence to be made with the purchaser.
- 35.3 Firm should intimate any change in their Address/Telephone/Fax/e-mail immediately. The state of non-communication with firm at any stage will make the offer/contract liable for rejection and cancellation respectively.

36. QUERY AND CLARIFICATIONS

- 36.1 In case of any contradiction noticed in this Tender Documents same be clarified within 07 days from the date of publication of tender on the website else decision/interpretation of NDRF in this regard would be final in all respect.



36.2 Queries/representations on Tender documents received up to Pre-Bid meeting would only be entertained and considered. All queries and representations received after the date of Pre-Bid Meeting are liable to be ignored.

The instructions given below are meant to assist the bidders in registering on the CPP Portal, prepare their bids in accordance with the requirements and submitting their bids online on the CPP Portal.

38.1 REGISTRATION


38.1.5 Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Please note that the bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSCs to others which may lead to misuse.

38.1.6 Bidder then logs in to the site through the secured log-in by entering their user ID / password and the password of the DSC / eToken.

38.2 SEARCHING FOR TENDER DOCUMENTS



SCHEDULE-V

DRAFT SPECIFICATION FOR FABRICATION OF EMERGENCY RESCUE VEHICLES (ERV) BY CONVERSION /REMODELLING OF EXISTING TROOP CARRIER VEHICLES

PREAMBLE:

The Emergency Rescue Van shall be fabricated/re-modeled on TATA 1613, 4200 mm wheel base which will be supplied by NDRF to the fabricator/ modulator firms.

- **STRUCTURE:** The Skelton structure will be mounted on Full length runner ISMC 100X50 on the chassis, the floor will be supported by cross bearers ISMC 75X40. And angles ASA 40X5. Body structure will be GI tube 2 mm thick.
- **PANNELING:** All external panels will be Aluminium plain sheet 2 mm the, Internal vertical panels will be aluminium chequered sheet 1.6 thk. Floor will be aluminium chequered sheet minimum 3mm thick.
- **PAINTING:** PU Paint.
- **SLIDES :** Slides will be of supplied for drawers
- **DRAWERS:** Drawers will be all aluminium construction.
- **LIGHTS:** All illuminating lights will be LED
- All electrical std with Grand make light bar with PA system, flashing strobe beacons etc.

2. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:-

The vehicles shall confirm in all respect of the provisions contained in the M.V. Act 1988 and M.V. Rules 1989 or to any other statute modifications or re-enactments' thereon from time to time. All the equipment necessary for R.T.O.'s clearance shall be provided on vehicles. Permanent RTO registration and Insurance etc shall be in scope of Owner.

3. DATA, INFORMATION AND DRAWINGS:-

Full detailed information of the body shall be submitted with technical bid for evaluation and approval before fabrication/ re-modeling. The detailed drawing of the body showing details of construction etc. shall also be submitted.

4. DRIVERS AND CREW CAB:-

- 4.1 The Driver Cum Crew cabin shall be OEM fitted original cabin, designed for better & wide vision, enough working room inside the cabin & to have enough aesthetic value.
- 4.2 The first cabin shall house seating for Driver and Officer. The Second cabin shall house seating for at least 4 Rescue Workers.
- 4.3 The driver seat & Rescue officer seat shall be of an adjustable type (free Adjustable).
- 4.4 All the seats shall have foam cushion and shall be covered with best quality Rexene. Provisions shall be made to store BA (Breathing Apparatus) sets in the back rest of the driver, Officer and the crew seats with suitable clamps and brackets where the BA sets (single cylinder) shall rest and shall not be kept in a hanging conditions.
- 4.5 Two doors on each side shall be provided on the Driver cab-cum-crew compartment.
- 4.6 Doors shall be fitted with safety glasses and be of horizontally sliding type window. The glasses on all the windows and doors shall be fixed in aluminium sections powder coated. The sliding glasses shall be provided with spring loaded locks operated from inside the cabin.
- 4.7 Below the crew seat space shall be provided for storage of equipments like spare cylinders of the BA set of the same capacity.
- 4.8 Under the crew seat suitable accommodation to keep mechanical tool kit is to be provided.



- 4.9 The entire super structure of the vehicle including that of the driver cab shall be welded structure made from MS pressed sections and squares tubes of 2 mm thickness with aluminum paneling outside. The outer paneling shall be done from 2 mm aluminum sheet and from aluminum chequered plates 1.6 mm internally, except internal to top of the cabin which shall be lined with good quality rexin or Equivalent type Material.
- 4.10 Thermocol insulation of 25 mm thickness shall be sandwiched between top of the cabin panels (2 mm thick aluminum) with rexin internally.
- 4.11 All the MS material used shall be treated for anti-corrosion before paneling is done.
- 4.12 The complete floor and top of the locker compartment shall be covered with 3 mm aluminum chequered plates.
- 4.13 The bottom plate for driver and crew cabin shall be 3 mm aluminum chequered plate.
- 4.14 A light bar of 1700 mm long operated on 12V battery having 2 Nos. of Rotating Beacon lights, 4 Nos. Strobe lights, hooter and PA system with built in amplifier and a microphone shall be provided in front of officer's seat in the Driver's Cabin.

5. **REAR BODY:**

- 5.1 The rear body shall have minimum seven roller shutters 4 on each side & 1 on rear side. Strong grab rails and non-skid steps shall be provided wherever necessary
- 5.2 2 Nos. of double pipe grab rails mounted on double pipe sockets shall be provided on both the sides of the vehicle.
- 5.3 Suitable arrangement for climbing on the top from rear side to be provided.
- 5.4 The roof of the vehicle shall of 1.6 mm aluminium chequered plate and their joints shall be given enough sealing to make the roof water tight

6. **LOCKERS FOR STOWAGE OF EQUIPMENT:-**

- 6.1 List of equipments chambers wise to be kept in the vehicle and the dimensions of the chambers is attached as Annexure – A.
- 6.2 All equipment as per attached list shall fit within two TATA 1613/42 wheel base chassis.
- 6.3 The lockers shall have smooth operation. The aluminium shutters shall be of reputed make only made of extruded aluminium construction duly powder coated. The shutters shall be of roller type only and not sliding type. The shutter doors shall be equipped with electro-magnetic switch on the door tracks to provide automatic switch on/off of compartment lights.
- 6.4 All the space below the rear body floor and chassis shall be utilized for making lockers for storage of equipment. These lockers shall be covered with Flap type doors opening downwards. Heavy duty chains and hinges shall be provided on these doors so that these doors when open, can be used as climbing steps for access to the lockers above it.
- 6.5 The lockers shall be provided with a combination of fixed shelves and drawers as required to store the equipment as per the latest international standards, i.e. roll-in roll-out type fixed with double ball bearings (sealed types) which shall open in tapered position giving very easy and immediate access to all equipment.
- 6.6 All equipment shall be stowed very scientifically and systematically in the shelves and drawers and each piece of equipment shall have its own designated location show that at the time emergency the required equipment can be very easily located and removed for use.
- 6.7 Location of equipment (lables) shall be provided on each shelf/drawers for immediate identification.
- 6.8 Each equipment shall be properly clamped and strapped in the shelf/drawers to prevent shifting of the equipment while the vehicle is in motion.
- 6.9 The drawers shall be totally fabricated from 3 mm aluminium sheets, corners covered by S.S. angle frame.
- 6.10 All the joints of the aluminium sheets shall be welded.
- 6.11 The drawers shall be fitted with self-locking system to prevent accidental opening while the vehicle is in motion.



- 6.12 A thick rubber sheet shall be fixed at the bottom of all the drawers to avoid damage to the equipment stored in it.
- 6.13 Sufficient numbers of shelves and Roll in Roll out drawers shall be provided to store the equipment.
- 6.14 One locker with some adjustable arrangement to be kept empty so that any one or two additional items can be kept in the vehicle considering hazard.
- 6.15 A strong platform with ramp shall be provided for mounting one standard 100 cc and above motor cycle at rear of rescue tender with heavy duty chains and hinges.

7. **MANUAL TURNING LIGHT MAST:-**
 - 7.1 Telescopic Light Mast pneumatically operated through the vehicle air tank should be fixed rigidly at a suitable location of vehicle in such a manner that it should not be damaged due to any jerks.
 - 7.2 It should be extendable up to a steady height of approx 5 mtrs from ground level and fitted with 4 x 50 W LED Lights (20,000 Lumens) through a Fixed Light Support Head.
 - 7.3 The control of lighting mast should be provided in driver's cabin to operate mast and light.
 - 7.4 Permanent connections for taking power supply from a power source set through spiral wire in protective sleeve shall be provided along with the earthed sockets at the Light Supports.
 - 7.5 Mast shall be made of extruded seamless aluminium construction, anodized in natural color, to be operated by vehicle generator.
8. **ACCESSORIES & ELECTRICAL FITTINGS:-**

The following accessories/fittings shall be provided on the vehicles at suitable location:-

 - 8.1 Search Light – 1 No. adjustable to give flood or beam light and will be mounted in convenient position on the vehicle but at the same time, will be capable of being readily removed and mounted on tripods away from the vehicle. These will each be supplied complete with tripod and not less than 30 m of TRS cable on reel mounted on the vehicle.
 - 8.2 Spot lights – 2 Nos.
 - 8.3 Fog lights low mounted in front of vehicle – 2 Nos.
 - 8.4 Reversing lights suitable situated to assist reversing – 2 Nos on rear side (like Luxury Buses Protected from Wire Grill)
 - 8.5 Wind screen wipers electrically operated – (As provided with Chassis)
9. **WORKMANSHIP AND MATERIAL:**
 - 9.1 Workmanship executed shall be of the highest order.
 - 9.2 All rivets and bolt holes shall have a coat of approved paint on both surfaces before riveting or bolting or welding.
 - 9.3 All steel screws, bolts, nuts, rivets etc. shall be zinc coated or shall have rust proof coats by a recognized process.
 - 9.4 The roof joints shall be subjected to rigid water tanks at the firms workshop in presence of purchasers representative.
 - 9.5 All directions and instructions on all points related to fabrications shall be executed whenever given by the Purchasers' representative for quality workmanship.
 - 9.6 All the material to be used in the fabrication of the body work shall be of good quality or approved make and type.
 - 9.7 All equipments and material shall comply with the requirements of the latest relevant IS specifications.
 - 9.8 The structure of the vehicle shall be rattling free and noiseless while in motion.
 - 9.9 There shall be no welding on the chassis.

10. **PAINTING & MARKING:-**

- 10.1 The entire Emergency Rescue Vehicle shall be painted with P.O. Orange Glossy Finish Dupont/ Asian PPG paint & thickness of 0.12 to 0.2 mm thickness, using double coat spray painting on the outside.



- 10.2 The NDRF logo & name will be painted at suitable places specified by the purchaser at the time of prototype.
- 10.3 The chassis and wheel arches will be painted black.
- 10.4 Two coats of anticorrosion & one zinc phosphate-priming coat will be applied before final painting of ERV. The vehicle will be clearly and permanently marked with the following, preferably on a metal plate attached in the driver's cabin & rear side of vehicle.

10.4.1 Manufacturer's name or trademark

10.4.2 Year of manufacture

10.4.3 Engine & Chassis Nos.

All instrument controls will be identified with nameplates.
